Custodial Operating Environment White Paper

Abstract

The Aziel Interface is a custodial, security-first operating environment designed to host, view, and preserve user-generated sites under conditions of silence, integrity, and user sovereignty.

It replaces platform authority with interface custody, emphasizing irreversible actions, explicit intent, and verifiable truth over convenience or scale.

Core Principles

Custody over reach: the user retains direct control of presence and withdrawal.

Integrity over availability: truth continuity is preserved even if services disappear.

Silence over amplification: no ranking, tracking, or algorithmic discovery.

AZHome Bunker Browser

AZHome is the native browsing layer of the Aziel Interface.

All AZ sites are ARK-encrypted and render only within the interface.

Conventional browsers cannot interpret, verify, or render AZ content.

User-Controlled Site States

Each site includes interface-level controls for ON, OFF, and FULL SHUTDOWN.

Traffic control is explicit and immediate.

There is no background serving once a site is disabled.

Identity Genesis & One-Time Keying

At first boot, the interface derives a one-time Genesis Hash Key from an initial username.

The username is never stored or requested again.

The Genesis Hash Key anchors access, verification, and custody continuity.

Integrity Enforcement & Scorched Earth

The interface continuously evaluates integrity conditions.

Upon terminal compromise, Scorched Earth logic executes locally.

All locks associated with the Genesis Hash Key are irreversibly deleted.

Witness & Memorialization

Aziel bears witness to terminal events without acting on user data.

A sealed witness record is generated containing event order and integrity state.

The vault remains untouched; only proof is preserved.

Privacy Model

No favorites, no personalization, no behavioral memory.

Natural metadata scrub prevents persistent linkage between sessions.

Continuity belongs to the user, not the interface.

Conclusion

The Aziel Interface is not a platform but a custody instrument.

It exists to hold, withdraw, and remember without coercion or amplification.
