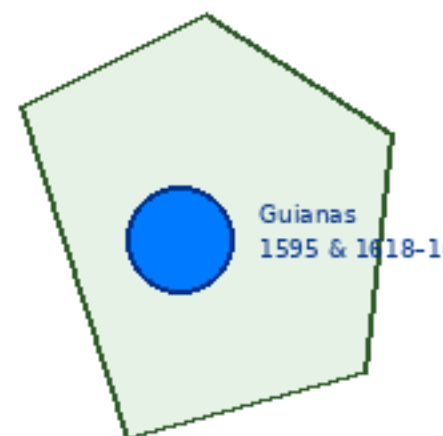
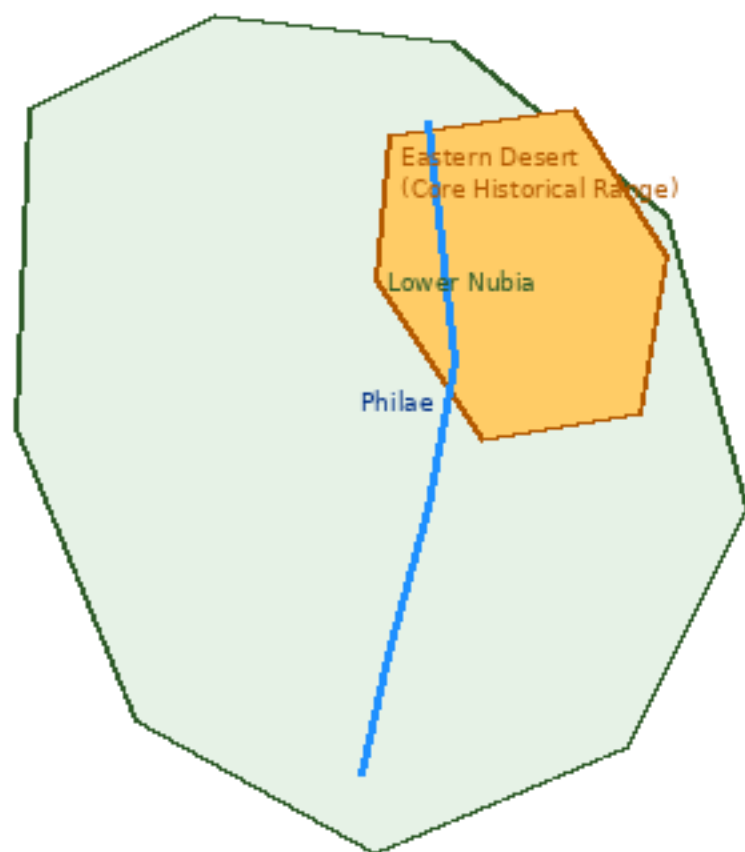


Blemmyes / Ewaipanoma Scatter Pattern with Timeline Anchors

~7th c. BC - Late Antiquity
Real Blemmyes in Africa

Classical (Herodotus → Pliny)
Myth begins to attach

Medieval Europe
Monstrous version spreads

1595 - Raleigh (Guiana)
Independent account

1618-1625 - Lourenszoön
Second independent account

Legend & Interpretation

Core African Range (Strongest historical presence)

Independent New World Accounts (1595 & 1618-1625)

Pattern most consistent with: African origin → possible scattered remnants over time or myth traveling with European exploration and re-applied to new testimonies

Northern/colder expansion = High mortality risk (per model)
