Canonical term for the issue cluster. Not a product. Not a protocol. A name so the papers can be filed.

Unowned Lattice (UL): a shop-structure that runs on legal minimum, purpose-built fog, family talk, reviews that cannot stop, and verbs parked on systems — and that stays unnamed by assigning the name to whoever assembles those members.

Definition

The term has three locked beats. They are not modules. They are one condition stated in order.

Lattice. The members brace each other: legal minimum used as morality, ambiguity kept as inventory, “we’re a family” as cover, process theater after harm, blame-the-model as the current wrapper. Remove one member and the others still hold.

Unowned. The brace is public and still has no owner. Polite names arrived first (compliance, culture, governance, innovation). The audience is split. Frames eat one piece and go home. Unowned things are not hidden. They are lived in.

Renamed. When someone assembles the members, the shop puts the accuracy on that person. They become the culture problem, the misfit, the overreaction, or the ethics slide with no stop. The structure keeps having no name. The namer has several.

Superseded (do not cite as live)

NDP-WP-1.0 Named Decision Protocol — toolkit draft. BAL-WP-1.1 Your Business Does This — change-directive draft. Both violated the issue-paper rule (name the structure and stop). Kept only as provenance.

How to file it

Cite the cluster as Unowned Lattice (UL). Cite a paper by BAL ID. Do not file this under DecisionGATE, TemporalLock, ForgeReceipts, AZ-OS, or any Lock module. Those are other work. UL is an issue cluster about a shop condition. A later toolkit, if one is ever asked for, gets a different term. Mixing them is how the lattice turns an issue into a slide.

Standing rule on this family: issue papers name a structure and stop. Recognition is not a kit.
